The 9th Annual National Prisoner Reentry Conference, sponsored by the Christian Association for Prison Aftercare, (CAPA), will held October 7th – 10th, 2010 in Milwaukee, WI. If you are interested in submitting a workshop proposal for the 2010 conference, please forward the requested information to the CAPA office after reading the information below. **The deadline for proposals is 3/26/2010.**

4. Impact of topic and information (enlightening and interesting)
5. Program balance

1. All workshop presentations are expected to last 80 minutes. If you are selected as a co-presenter you will have 45 minutes.
